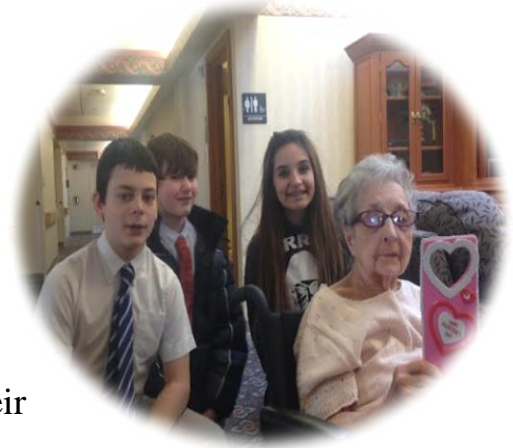


Seventh Grade
